Comments: The undersigned made an announced visit to the conservatee's current residence on 02/24/26. Prior to the visit the undersigned requested an American Sign Language (ASL) interpreter. Evelyn Rivera from CIS Interpreting assisted the undersigned during the announced visit.

The conservatee was interviewed privately in his room. The conservatee was observed to be ambulatory without assistance. The conservatee had good hygiene, wore clean clothes, and was dressed appropriately. The conservatee appeared to be in stable health but was observed to breathe heavily.

Cavan was observed to be friendly and conversational. He was advised of the conservatorship, the conservator, and his rights. When asked if he had any concerns he responded, "my concern is that I don't want to be here any longer." He shared that he has recently been experiencing issues with a specific resident of the facility and indicated that he no longer feels comfortable.

Cavan reported that he would prefer to move in with his father so he could "help take care of him."

Further he expressed a desire to be more independent. He shared that he has "tried to stay patient," but his primary goal is to gain independence. Cavan's reported plan is to regain employment and eventually move out "to my own place." Cavan did not appear certain if he desired for the conservatorship to continue but did not believe the conservatorship should continue if it meant he had to continue to reside at his current residence.

STATEMENT OF CONSERVATOR(S):

The undersigned spoke telephonically with the San Gabriel Pomona Regional Center Service Coordinator, Silvia Moniot, following the announced visit. Ms. Moniot reported that she is aware that Cavan has been having issues with a resident at Workman Lane. She shared that he has had issues with trying to “restrain” and “control” the resident which has led to complaints by neighbors and a wellness check by law enforcement. She shared that Cavan has resided independently in the past, but he had issues with allowing unhoused people to live in his home and difficulty managing his ADL’s. Ms. Moniot reported that they have a shared goal of Cavan being able to live independently but at this time it would be difficult due to concerns regarding his physical health. She shared that in addition to struggling with his weight and maintaining a healthy diet, he was asked to wear a CPAP machine and refused. Further she reported concerns about him being able to manage and prioritize his health needs if he were to reside independently. Ms. Moniot indicated that transferring Cavan could be viable option, but his father has expressed his desire for Cavan to reside in a facility where all the residents are deaf. She shared that there are no other facilities where all residents are deaf in the San Gabriel Pomona region. According to Ms. Moniot, the staff at Workman Lane are fully trained in American Sign Language. She reported that Cavan’s father has been supportive and communicative but sometimes attempts to influence his decisions. Ms. Moniot reported that the conservatee has previously worked temporary jobs at Amazon but presently attends ICON Adult Day Program five days a week. She shared that she visits Cavan quarterly.
